Entry Measures for Thai and Foreign Nationals (From 1 July 2022)

- Thailand Pass registration scheme (<https://tp.consular.go.th/>) not required
- Certificate of vaccination or an RT-PCR / Professional ATK COVID-19 test result issued within 72 hours before departure
- Medical insurance not required
- Airlines will check your documents be

People who are not eligible to enter Thailand under the Visa on Arrival scheme or Visa Exemption rule are required to obtain a visa through a Royal Thai Embassy or Consulate prior to their visit.
